<b>Narrative</b> <p>The City of Watertown received more than 2 inches of snow accumulation on January 20, 2012. As a result, the Watertown Street Department will be plowing the uptown area and streets on January 23, 2012.</p> <p><b>On Monday, January 23, 2012, beginning at 3:00 A.M., the Watertown Street Department will be plowing the uptown business district. Upon completion, the Watertown Street Department will plow streets. Residents must remove their vehicles from the street on this date to avoid ticketing.</b></p> <p>Parking on streets when they are scheduled to be plowed will result in a \$40 fine (fine doubles to \$80 if not paid in 3 days). Officers will do same day ticketing of vehicles blocking the snow plows from clearing the city streets. If the obstructing vehicles remain on the street longer than 24 hours after being plowed around, it will be towed at the expense of the owner.</p> <p>Watertown City Ordinance restricts residents from blowing snow into the street from a driveway or sidewalk.</p> <p>The Watertown Street and Police Department appreciate the cooperation and understanding of residents in removing cars to provide for effective snow removal on City streets.</p>
