<b>Narrative</b> <b>On Tuesday, January 24, 2012, beginning at 5:00 A.M., the Watertown Street Department will be plowing Highways 212, 81 and 20. Upon completion, the Watertown Street Department will plow avenues. Residents must remove their vehicles from the avenue on this date to avoid ticketing.</b>  <b>Parking on avenues when they are scheduled to be plowed will result in a \$40 fine (fine doubles to \$80 if not paid in 3 days). Officers will do same day ticketing of vehicles blocking the snow plows from clearing the city avenues. If the obstructing vehicles remain on the avenue longer than 24 hours after being plowed around, it will be towed at the expense of the owner.</b>  <b>Watertown City Ordinance prohibits residents from blowing snow into the street or avenue from a driveway or sidewalk.</b>  <b>The Watertown Street and Police Department appreciate the cooperation and understanding of residents in removing cars to provide for effective snow removal on City streets.</b>
